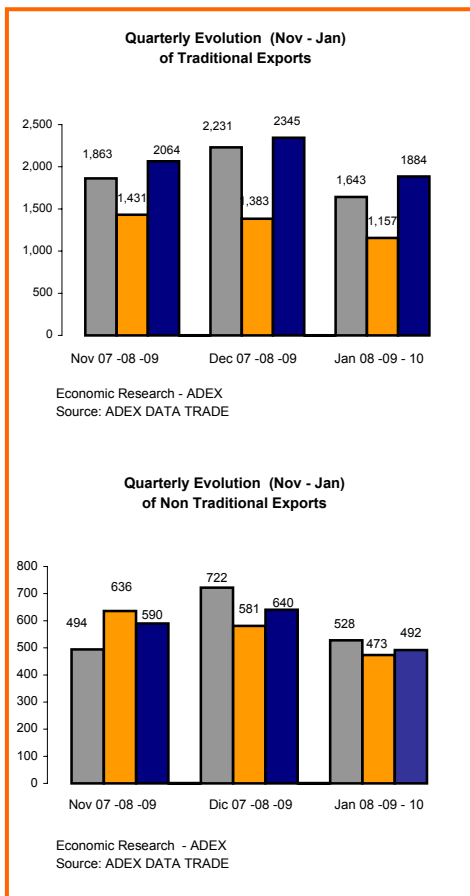

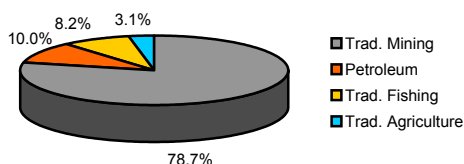

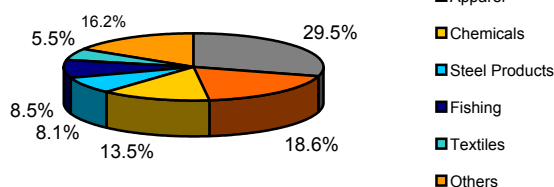

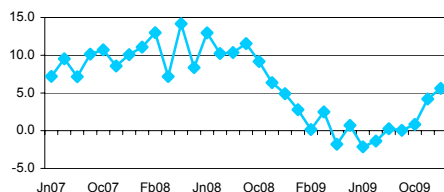
Traditional Exports by Sector 2009



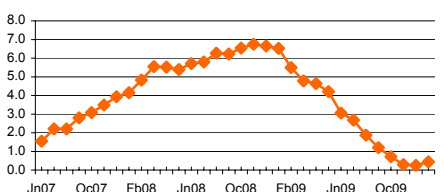
Non Traditional Exports by Sector 2009

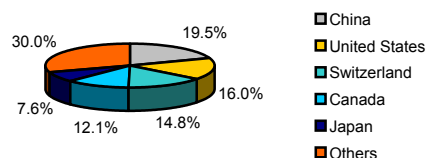

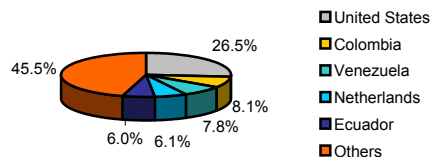
